Puppy Checklist

- **Make your vet appointment**
 - Puppies need an initial veterinarian visit within 3 business days of bringing your Pinnacle puppy home.
 - A copy of your puppy's health records will be provided to you.
- **Interview trainers**
 - Set up an appointment within 3 business days of pick up.
 - "Animal Behaviorist" are the key terms you are looking for.
 - Group classes can begin at 4 months of age, after all shots are completed.
- **Activate your Trupanion pet insurance!**
 - We use Trupanion
 - You will receive a breeder code to activate your free 30-day Trupanion offer.
 - Activate your offer **within 24 hours before or after** you bring your puppy home- it is time-sensitive.
 - Your GO HOME DAY OFFER includes:
 - Immediate coverage- waived waiting periods!
 - 30 days coverage with no upfront payment
- **Supplements & Vitamins**
 - We highly recommend daily supplements/vitamins for your puppy. We use and recommend NuVet Plus, tablets. We will provide you with a breeder code.
 - NuVet uses only the highest quality, human grade ingredients. Their supplements are a combination of essential vitamins, minerals and antioxidants. All ingredients are sources in the USA and cold pressed to ensure maximum nutritional potency.
- **Buy a wire crate**
 - We DO NOT recommend a corral. The wire crate will help continuing training and keeping your puppy safe.
 - Highly recommend you purchase your wire crate online as it can save you over \$50.
 - Ensure you crate has two doors and a divider.
 - Mediums do best with a 42" wire crate.
 - We will provide a go-home sleeping crate.
- **Dog Food**
 - Your puppy has been on Victor Hi-Pro Plus. We highly recommend Victor.
- **Toys & Treats**
 - Ensure toys are safe for dogs.
 - We love snufflemats for critical thinking skills.
 - Puzzle toys to keep puppy engaged.



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- High quality training treats.
- Himalayan Yak Chews are a favorite at Pinnacle.
- *Remember: a bored puppy is a destructive puppy!*
- **Food & Water Bowls**
 - We prefer a metal water bowl and a slow-feeder puzzle bowl for meals.
- **Crate Cover**
 - Purchase a large blanket, sheet, or crate cover to completely cover your wire crate. This will provide a “den-like” atmosphere.
- **ID Tag, Leash, & Collar**
 - *Bring these to pickup so they can be sized accurately.*
 - Medium: size small collar & size small 6ft leash
- **Miscellaneous Items**
 - Bitter Apple Spray: spray on items you do not want your puppy to chew on. This is a deterrent, not a guarantee.
 - Slicker brush. We highly recommend the Chris Christensen slicker brush.
 - Stainless steel dog comb
 - Shampoo, Conditioner, Detangler, etc. We highly recommend Cowboy Magic products. For serums we recommend Moroccan Oil to keep the coat healthy and soft.

Important FYI

- Your puppy should not go to the groomer until they are 16 weeks of age and have had all their shots. Regular at-home and professional grooming is critical to coat health and your puppy’s tolerance to grooming products.
- Research line brushing. This is critical to properly grooming and maintaining your Australian Labradoodle's beautiful coat.
